Precautions	Contains ALCOOL ETHOXYLE C9 C11 8 OE and CHLORHYDRATE BIGUANIDE POLYMERIQUE
Instructions for use	Preparation (0.5% strength solution): 1. Wear protective eyewear and gloves. 2. Use a disinfection tray with graded measurements and a lid. 3. Dilute 5ml per litre of water (i.e. 20ml in 4l of water). Usage: 1. Fully immerse the (opened or dismantled) dental instruments. 2. Immersion time: 15 minutes. 3. Rinse thoroughly. The solution must be changed as soon as it becomes dirty or at least once daily.

Risk phrases:

- R38: Irritating to skin.
- R41: Risk of serious damage to eyes.
- R43: May cause sensitisation by skin contact.
- R50: Very toxic to aquatic organisms.
